

## **Staying COVID Safe**

At the Bridge Hotel, the safety and wellbeing of our guests and staff has always been our highest priority. To ensure we keep both our guests and staff safe, we are carrying out an extra rigorous cleaning regime.

Here's what we are doing to keep you and our staff safe:

### **Pre-Arrival**

Prior to your arrival we will email you an information letter advising you of the changes that have been made to assist in remaining COVID safe. You will be asked that you advise us if you or your household have had any recent symptoms of COVID.

### **Checking in and social distancing**

We have minimised contact at reception with Perspex screens, and social distancing measures are in place. Hand sanitisers are located at every entrance to the Hotel and we encourage the use of these at all times.

### **Hygiene and anti-viricidal spray**

More frequent cleaning of high touch areas, such as door handles, handrails and check in areas with viricidal disinfectant are undertaken daily. In the bedrooms we are paying special attention to door handles, all electrical equipment, light and power switches.

As an extra precaution, we ask that you vacate your room whilst our housekeepers attend daily.

### **Bed Linen**

All our linen is laundered off site at over 60 degrees, with disinfectant detergent so you can enjoy a great night's sleep in comfort.

### **Dining at the Hotel**

All dining is by allocated/reserved time only. Breakfast is by pre-order to minimise contact between staff and guests and evening meals are available in our dining room and public bar. It is full table service in both locations, and guests/patrons are encouraged to remain seated throughout the dining experience.

We encourage all guests to take advantage of the amazing landscape surrounding the Bridge Hotel, and packed lunches are available for daily collection for those long walks (or even for the short ones).

### **Protective Equipment for our staff**

We've provided all our staff with protective equipment, including face coverings, gloves, aprons and hand sanitiser.
