### Wainwright Golden Ale (4.1%)

Wainwright is a shimmering golden ale with subtle sweetness and delicate citrus fruity overtones. Sweet honey flavours compliment a fruitful flavour from the yeast, whilst a soft woody citrus comes through from the hops.



### Whistling Pig (5%)

### Jinny Howelt (4.1%)

### Jennings Cumberland Ale (4%)

Pleasing to the eye with its tawny complexion, this classic bitter has a modest nutty taste a rousing bitter finish. Highly drinkable



### Wainwright Amber Ale (4%)

With a subtle bitterness and delicately enticing hop balance, Wainwright Amber is satisfyingly moreish. Clean, creamy and lightly Fruity; a pint at the pinnacle of perfection. Brewed with 100% English malt.



### Mowdy Pale Ale (4%)

## MALTS AND MORE

### Lowlands

---

#### **Glenkinchie 12 yr old** £4.80

The nose is fresh, with spices and citrus fruits, oak, plus a final hint of marshmallow. Medium-bodied, smooth, sweet and fruity, with malt, butter and cheesecake, together with more oak. The finish is comparatively long and drying, initially rather herbal.

#### **Auchentoshan 12yr old** £4.00

One of the only triple-distilled single malt Scotch whiskies. With offers of cereals, almonds and lime on the nose and tastes of sweet caramelised toffee with hints of dried orange and grapefruit on the palate. The finish is dry and long with lingering nuttiness. Ock-un-tosh-un: let it roll off your tongue.

### Highlands

---

#### **Glenmorangie 10 yr old** £4.30

The nose offers fresh fruits, butterscotch and toffee. Silky smooth in the mouth, slightly less spice and nutty, with well-mannered spices coming through more in the medium length finish. The finish has less caramel character than previously, and a final hint of ginger.

#### **Dalwhinnie 15 yr old** £4.90

The nose is fresh and aromatic, with pine needles, heather and vanilla plus delicate peat notes. Sweet and balanced on a smooth fruity palate, with honey, malt and a very subtle note of peat. The medium length finish dries elegantly. One of the highest distilleries in Scotland.

#### **Oban 14 yr old** £5.50

Lightly smoky on the honeyed, floral nose. Toffee, cereal and a hint of peat, along with a whiff of the seashore. The palate offers initial cooked fruits, becoming spicier. Complex, bittersweet, malt, oak and more gentle smoke. The finish is quite lengthy and aromatic, with spicy oak, toffee and a touch of new leather.

#### **Royal Lochnagar 12 yr old** £4.70

Situated close to Balmoral Castle, and known to be a favourite of Queen Victoria and Prince Albert, this medium bodied single malt is subtle, fresh and woody. On the nose there is a fragrant linseed oil and sweet toffee aroma offset by fresh acidity. The palate is pleasantly balanced, finishing on sandalwood notes.

## MALTS AND MORE

### Speyside

---

#### **Cragganmore 12 yr old** £4.50

A complex nose of Sherry, brittle toffee, nuts, heather, mild wood smoke, angelica and mixed peel. Elegant on the malty palate, with almonds, herbal and fruit notes. Medium in length, with a slightly peppery, smoky finish.

#### **Glenfarclas 10 yr old** £4.40

The 10-year-old exhibits a nose of rich Christmas cake, featuring most notably Sherry, raisins, nuts and spices. A background hint of smoke is also present. The palate is defined by quite dry Sherry, with a developing and gradually sweetening full body. The finish is long, nutty, and comparatively dry.

#### **Glenfiddich 12 yr old** £4.50

Possessed of a delicate, floral, slightly fruity nose, this Glenfiddich is well mannered in the mouth, malty, elegant and soft. Rich, fruit flavours dominate the palate, with a developing nuttiness and an elusive whiff of peat smoke in the fragrant finish.

#### **The Glenlivet 12 yr old** £4.30

A lovely, honeyed, floral, fragrant nose. Medium-bodied, smooth and malty on the palate, with vanilla sweetness. Not as sweet, however, as the nose might suggest. The finish is pleasantly lengthy and sophisticated .

## MALTS AND MORE

### Island

---

**Highland Park 12 yr old Orkney** £4.30

The nose is fragrant and floral, with hints of heather and some spice. Smooth and honeyed on the palate, with citric fruits, malt and distinctive tones of wood smoke in the warm, lengthy, slightly peaty, finish.

**Bunnahabhain 12 yr old Islay** £5.20

Fresh on the nose, with light peat and discreet smoke. More overt peat on the nutty and fruity palate, but still restrained for an Islay. The finish is full-bodied and lingering, with a hint of vanilla and some smoke.

**Caol Ila 12yr old Islay** £4.90

Intensely rich with malted barley and gentle floral touches overcome by smokey notes on the nose. Fairly light in texture with notes of toffee vanilla and pear joined by a hint of ash on the very back of the palate.

**Ardbeg 10yr old Islay** £4.60

Revered around the world as the peaty-est, smokiest and most complex single malt of them all, yet it does not flaunt the peat – rather it gives way to the natural sweetness of the malt to produce a whiskey of perfect balance. Named world whiskey of the year in 2008.

**Laphraoig 10 yr old Islay** £5.50

Old-fashioned peat smoke and seaweed leap off the nose, followed by something a little sweeter and fruitier. Massive on the palate, with fish oil, salt and plankton, though the finish is surprisingly tight and increasingly drying.

**Isle of Jura 10 yr old Jura** £3.80

Resin, oil and pine notes on the delicate nose, light bodied in the mouth, with malt and during saltiness. The finish is malty, nutty, with more salt and perhaps just a wisp of smoke.

**Talisker 10 yr old Skye** £5.10

Quite dense and smoky on the nose, with smoked fish, bladderwrack, sweet fruit and peat. Full-bodied and peaty in the mouth, with ginger, dark chocolate, black pepper and a kick of chilli in the very long, smoky finish.

## MALTS AND MORE

### Irish Whiskey

---

**Bushmills** £3.40

First Impression on the palate is smooth sweetness, as this rich whiskey rolls around the mouth. There are toffee and dark caramel notes here, mingling with spicy hints that open up with a dash of water. Hints of fruit also appear after a while.

**Jamesons** £3.50

The nose offers an interesting combination of floral, orange, toffee, Sherry and spice notes. Water releases more cooked fruits and a suggestion of linseed. Initially citric in the mouth, along with classic Irish oiliness, more profound notes of Sherry develop along with fudge, vanilla and spice. The finish is long, warming and spicy, remaining oily to the very end.

### British Blended Malts

---

**Lakes Distillery “The One” Whiskey - Keswick** £4.10

A unique blend of exceptional British Isles whiskies, each has its own distinctive characteristics, and these have been blended with great care and passion, resulting in a whisky of intriguing complexity. Slightly smoky, sweet and fruity, nutty with hints of spice.

### Blends

---

**Monkey Shoulder** £3.40

Aromas of oak, hint of port/sherry, floral, vanilla, citrus. Slight port sweetness, wood, oak, honey, lemon peel. Medium length, slight bitterness, drying towards the end.

**Grouse** £3.40

Lovely, delicate and floral on the nose – grains and malt working in perfect harmony. Deceptively rich and full for what is really quite a light bodied blend. Fruity with a touch of smoke.

**Bells** £3.40

The nose of Original offers cereal, yeast and slightly ‘mashy’ notes, with a floral background and fresh fruits. The addition of water produces a distinct impression of pent matches.

### American Whiskey

---

**Jack Daniels** £3.50

Fairly sweet with tones of oak, vanilla, and charcoal. Light bodied with short aftertaste.

**Jack Daniels Honey** £3.50

A mix of regular Old No 7 and a spiced honey liqueur, it’s got spice, sweetness, floral undertones and a long smooth finish. Drink over ice, chilled or even in a cup of coffee – it’s rather tasty .
